Establishment of Integrated ICT infrastructure and system:

- Phase I: Establishment of AHA Centre’s ICT infrastructure, along with capacity-building related activities for the AHA Centre ICT personnel and AMS
- Phase II: Enhancement of connectivity between the AHA Centre and AMS National Disaster Management Offices
- Phase III: Establishment of a disaster recovery backup and Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) backup office
- Phase IV: Improvement of ICT infrastructure using cloud system and development of the [ICT Roadmap on Disaster Management for 2025 and Beyond](#); organisation of ASEAN Workshop on Disaster Reporting and Big Data for Disaster Management attended by more than 90 participants
