## PRIORITY PROGRAMME 5,6

### PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE



Disaster Emergency Logistics System for ASEAN (DELSA):

- Establishment of regional stockpile of relief items in three satellite warehouses in Malaysia, Thailand, and the Philippines
- Mobilisation of DELSA relief items to assist in **31** disaster emergency operations in **7** ASEAN countries as of December 2020
- DELSA Familiarisation and AHA Centre Crisis Communication Training (ACT) among **46** participants
- Public awareness of AADMER, AHA Centre, and ASEAN's disaster emergency logistic systems through various publications



Transformation of ASEAN-Emergency Response and Assessment Team (ASEAN-ERAT) with around **200** ASEAN-ERAT members are trained and at least five ASEAN-ERAT deployment missions



**118** graduates from six batches of the AHA Centre Executive (ACE) Programme as of December 2022

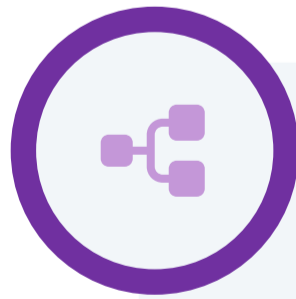

## PRIORITY PROGRAMME 8

### KNOWLEDGE AND INNOVATION MANAGEMENT



Establishment of Integrated ICT infrastructure and system:

- Phase I: Establishment of AHA Centre's ICT infrastructure, along with capacity-building related activities for the AHA Centre ICT personnel and AMS
- Phase II: Enhancement of connectivity between the AHA Centre and AMS National Disaster Management Offices
- Phase III: Establishment of a disaster recovery backup and Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) backup office
- Phase IV: Improvement of ICT infrastructure using cloud system and development of the ICT Roadmap on Disaster Management for 2025 and Beyond; organisation of ASEAN Workshop on Disaster Reporting and Big Data for Disaster Management attended by more than 90 participants
