Since 2009, capacity building activities such as trainings, workshops, and seminars on various transnational crime topics, including arms smuggling, terrorism, and trafficking in persons, benefited at least 611 ASEAN Member State law enforcement offcials.

More recently, 48 stakeholders attended the ASEAN-Japan Workshop on Technology-based Approach to Tackle Trafficking of Children in June 2022.

## Cybercrime

- A series of trainings and related meetings brought together more than **380** participants from across the region and more than **50** trainers and expert speakers from all over the world through the <u>ASEAN Cyber Capacity Development Project</u>.
- ► ASEAN Cyber Capacity Development Project Phase II (ACCDP II) rolled out National Cybercrime Strategy Guidebook, organised a series of cybercrime online trainings and workshops, participated by more than 300 participants, and launched an e-learning module on Identifying and Seizing Digital Evidence.
- ▶ Under the ASEAN Joint Operational Framework for Cybercrime (AJOC), the <u>ASEAN Desk</u> at INTERPOL Global Complex for Innovation (IGCI) has implemented two joint operations Nigh Furry (2019-2020) and Goldfish Alpha (2019), launched <u>ASEAN Cybercrime Knowledge Exchange (CKE)</u> Workspace and released the ASEAN Cyberthreat Assessments <u>2020</u> and <u>2021</u>.
